On 4th May, one of my colleagues requested me to lend him my car, as he wanted to go to Musaffah, at about 8pm. I tried to reach him after a few hours, but he did not respond. I continued trying and within next few hours, his mobile was switched off. I was restless till the morning. I couldn't attend church, on Friday, due to this reason; I couldn't trace him until Saturday, as I tried to reach all his friends and my colleagues, but no one had any information about him. Finally, on Sunday morning, I came to know through a friend, that he was detained by the police and was in the Al Ain prison. I panicked more, as there was no information about my car. I tried seeking the help of Abu Dhabi courts and the police station; I even went to the Al Ain prison to know about my car. Finally, I decided to file a complaint, but they refused to take up the case then and asked me to come after a week. It had been almost a week since I had lost my car. I went back to the Abu Dhabi Courts and met a police officer. He explained to me the legal issues that would arise due to this situation also that it would take them quite some time to trace the car, as there was no information, about the car, in the police records. He was asked to go to the prison and enquire about my car, from my colleague. I was very upset and had no clue, which way to go. At the court reception area, sitting in a corner, I just prayed asking God give me the wisdom and courage, as I was very disappointed with the whole issue; I pleaded with God to protect me from danger. Within a short time, I felt the urge to call the Al Ain prison authorities from the court, but it was difficult to convey my request, as no one could communicate in English. Finally, they transferred the call to the prison warden, who could speak & understand English. I explained my situation to him and he understood; he asked me to call back after sometime. I tried to reach him as I waited in the court, but there was no response. I returned home restless, but had not lost hope. I called him again and to my delight, he gave me a detailed address, where my car was parked, in a place called Al Shoaib, in the Al Ain desert area. That evening I went to search for my car, along with my friend and an Arab, the friend of my friend; he offered to drive us in his 4-wheel, and help us search for my car, as he knew the area very well. We reached there in the midnight and searching for the car was very difficult, as it was pitch dark. It took us nearly two hours, to search every part of that area; we also went to the Al Ain police station to confirm the address, yet we couldn't trace the car. Finally, we decided to return to Abu Dhabi; but I had already prayed in my heart to the Lord that I wasn't going from that place without my car. I requested the Arab Friend to take a final round, to search for my car; suddenly, I spotted my car covered with dust. I praise & thank God! In that pitch darkness, God showed me my car. I screamed and shouted with joy. The Arab friend said I would be in trouble, if there was any criminal case; so we inquired of the police and they said that I could move my car, without any problem. God's protection was mightily around my car and me; not only did God help me find the car, but He also secured me without any police case or car fines; there was not even a dent. God sent me help through this Arab friend, whom I did not know. He just smiled, checked the car, made sure that everything was OK and then he left. I returned home happily in my car, just as I had prayed. I have learned a good lesson, through this incident that you should not give your car to anyone. I request all my fellow church members to take this incident seriously. It took me 14 days to find the car. It did take long, but once I surrendered my situation into God's hand, He showed me the way and I got my car back, miraculously. Thank you, Lord Jesus for your strength and thank you Holy Spirit, for your guidance.
