I praised and thanked God for this blessing. After she recovered, I had to go back to work. We did not want to trouble anyone, so Subash decided to take Michelle to his office. Every morning we prayed that the security at his workplace would not stop us. We Praise God, as no one stopped us on those 5 days that Subash took Michelle to his workplace. Subash took care of Michelle at work and his colleagues were kind enough to look after her, during the time he had to drop me at my office, in mornings. Michelle was also very quiet and did not disturb him or the others at his office. God in His time makes all things beautiful. Finally, we found a Nanny (Shyamala) for the children and processed for her visa immediately. She's now with us since May 13 and is looking after the children very well. I want to thank Sis. Beverly's nanny Padma, Gladys Aunty, Sis. Shalet and Sis. Selina, who looked after the children, without any hesitation. Truly we are blessed to have all of them, in our life.

God is good all the time, our Provider and Caretaker! Praise God!
